Parent's Summer Camp Information: Dear Parents,

We are thrilled to be taking your child to summer camp in Kona, HI! To ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience, please take a look at the important details below:

Total Cost: \$1,500

- 1. Camp Registration: \$625
- 2. Flight Cost: Approximately \$600
- 3. Additional Expenses (Travel, Lodging, Food): Remaining balance

How Much Do You Need To Pay?

- While we are asking that all parents cover the full cost of camp (\$1,500) we are also doing several fundraisers to help cover the cost of any parents that cannot afford to pay the full amount for their children.

- Something to note is that we have a very diverse congregation with a wide range of economic brackets. We would like to ask that parents not rely on our fundraising efforts unless absolutely necessary, in order that we can assist those truly in need.

Down Payment:

- Despite the fact that we are hosting fundraisers, a non refundable down payment of \$725 is required for each student in order for us to purchase flight tickets ahead of time, and cover the camp down payment.

- If you cannot afford the down payment at this time, we encourage you to speak with your child about seeking personal sponsorships to cover the cost of the down payment.

- If this is still not possible, please contact Mercy (541) 941-5528 about setting up a payment plan with Real Life Church.

Deadlines

- 1. Down payment deadline: Your down payment of **\$725** is due 03-31-2024, 11:59am.
- 2. Remainder deadline: The remaining balance of **\$775** is due 06-15-2024, 11:59am.

Fundraiser Information

- We have many fundraisers coming up, and they won't operate like the typical youth fundraiser. Instead of doing only simple events like we have in the past such as bake sales or car washes, we've decided to host two very large events: a pickleball tournament, and a luau.

- The way we will gain money through these events is by gathering sponsors (small businesses making large charitable contributions) and providing them with benefits (branded merch items and special treatment at our events)

Refund Policy:

- Flight Cost: Non-refundable
- Lodging and Travel Costs: Non-refundable

- Camp Cost: Fully refundable if notified at least 2 weeks before camp date; \$100 processing fee for camp refunds

Important Notes:

- Your child is responsible for bringing money for merchandise, snacks, and any additional food beyond what is provided.

- Camp registration includes lodging, meals, and various activities.

- Cabins will be provided for accommodations.

-What are the arrival and departure days?

On July 21st, 2024, at 9:00am Real Life Youth will be driving from Real Life Church, 2417 ave a, White City, to San Francisco and staying in a hotel the night before we fly to Kona, HI. On our return from HI we will also be staying the night in SF before returning in the morning. We will have your child contact you with an exact arrival time on the day of our return, August 2nd.

The flight arrivals and departures will occur on these dates: Arrival: July 22nd, 2024 Departure: Aug 1st, 2024

-What is the schedule like for the camp?

Each day we have a morning training session, afternoon small/passion groups, and in the evening we have worship and a message. Sprinkled throughout it all are games, rest times, bible times, etc. The aim is to have massive amounts of fun while discovering more about Jesus!

-What is the housing like?

Each camper will be placed in a room of similar-aged students with one or two room staff. We are unable to guarantee you will room with all your friends, but we have a place in the application to make known specific roommate requests.

-Are meals provided?

Camp price includes three meals a day and snacks. Each location will also have extra goodies for purchase.

-Are there refunds if I'm not able to come?

If a refund is requested for Kona RIDERS Camp there will be a \$100 processing fee. If a refund is requested for Dallas RIDERS Camp there will be a \$50 processing fee. If a refund is requested within two weeks of the camp starting for either location a refund may be unavailable and will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Refunds do not apply to students who decide to leave early or are asked to leave due to breaking certain camp rules.

We have also provided your child with a list of recommended items to pack, and the bags they will be allowed to bring.
